Key issue significance: climactic battle between the original X-Men and the All-New team; first appearance and naming of the “Fastball Special” (Colossus launching Wolverine); sets up the start of the Phoenix saga.

CGC CENSUS — POPULATION CONTEXT

5,192 copies of X-Men #100 graded across all CGC categories; 4,596 (88.5%) are Universal (blue label). The 9.4 grade accounts for 581 of all graded copies (11.2% of total population) and 515 Universal copies, placing a 9.4 in the top ~21% of all Universal-graded copies of this issue by grade.

MARKET ANALYSIS

X-Men #100 is a significant Bronze Age key: the climax of the original-vs-new-team storyline, the debut of the “Fastball Special,” and the lead-in to the Phoenix saga. Demand is broad rather than speculative — GoCollect records 247 confirmed sales at the 9.4 grade alone, one of the deepest sales histories of any grade for this issue. Pricing scales smoothly across neighboring grades (\$300 at 9.2 → an estimated \$400–450 at 9.4 → \$550 at 9.6), consistent with a stable, well-collected key rather than a book prone to sudden spikes.
